(Fun fact: It takes about 1,500 tabs to equal one pound). Many Access Medical and Ascension Borgess Health employees regularly donate pull tabs to benefit HHH's mission: to make it easier for families to support their loved one receiving medical care by providing a homelike, comforting place to stay.

Recently, the HHH opened its second new house at 828 Burdick St. to give out-of-town patients and their families greater peace of mind during a medical crisis. While they might seem tiny or expendable, every pull tab makes a difference. Learn how you can help at hhkz.org.

1. Make sure your equipment fits you: Having clubs too heavy/light with shafts that are too strong/weak can be detrimental to your game.
2. Use the Winter to focus on your fundamentals: It's a great time to make sure your grip, stance and posture are up to par to ensure consistency and balance in your game.
3. Know Your Distances: Tour players can narrow down their distances by the yard with each club. Can you?
4. Use the Simulator to Improve Course Management: Top down views of the holes allow you a bird's-eye view of the hole and can be useful for understanding how to play to your strengths on the course.
5. Check Your Grips: Grips wear down over time from heavy use. If you notice your grips are slipping in your hands or show wear/tear talk to the staff about getting new grips on your clubs.

X-Golf is located in the Westwood Plaza shopping center at the corner of West Main and Drake. Mike is available to assist you with improving your game. X-Golf features six state-of-the-art golf simulators that allow for incredibly accurate tracking of the golf ball and over 65 golf options for playing and practicing.
